- Encouraged taking over new areas







 Social Darwinismtheory of evolution used to explain human societies






4. Nationalism

- Communication, supplies, troops, etc.




3. Medicine

- Quinine- 1829 medicine protected Europeans




COMMON SYMPTOMS OF MALARIA

Discoveries of diamonds (1867) and gold (1886) turn the scramble for African territory into high gear


Berlin Conference 1884-85
