




Six Degrees of Separation


How does our interconnectedness effect culture?

As cultures become increasingly connected through technology, social movements have begun to spread more rapidly.






Cultural Lag

Material culture (objects) usually changes first with nonmaterial culture (beliefs, values, etc.) lagging behind.



Cultural Diffusion

- The spread of cultural traits from one group to another.
- Includes both material and nonmaterial culture
